Troop 652 Parent Committee Meeting Notes

I. Call to Order/Opening Remarks

Denise called to order the regular meeting of the Troop 652 Parent Committee at 6:35 PM.

II. Scoutmaster Open Discussion

- Klondike is January 24-26 at Beaumont. Both troops will tent camp at the event and share a campsite.
- Pack 652's crossover is scheduled for the first weekend of March. The girls' troop likes to attend Sap Camp in early March, and there may be an overlap. Sap Camp is scheduled for March 7-8, 2025.
- February's campout will probably be a polar bear, possibly at Richfield Heritage Preserve. No running water at campsites at that time of year. Both troops will attend. Leaders will need to check the drivability of the campsites in the wintertime. Check into whether a lodge is available for warming, if necessary.
- Discussion: Manatoc Summer Camp (June 15-21). Irene attended a summer camp pre-meeting. We may
 need to consider changing our campsite, Dan Beard, to one with larger space and accommodation for our
 group. Other options for larger campsites the week we are scheduled to attend. Possibly changing the week
 we attend for other larger, available campsites. Early bird price will be \$455/scout and \$150/adult leader.
 April 19 is the early bird registration deadline. Great Trail Council has a new policy to allow early bird pricing
 to Arrows that cross over after the April deadline.

III. Reports

Scoutmaster, Boys (Kevin)

- The boys' holiday party is on December 11 at Whirlyball in Bedford Heights.
- Congratulations to Justin who was elected as our new troop SPL (senior patrol leader). Grady and Kody will serve as ASPLs.
- The annual PLC training session, for all new youth leadership roles, was held last week.
- National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT) will be held June 8-14 at Firelands. By the start of NYLT, Scouts must be at least 13, have achieved First Class rank, and need a unit leader recommendation. Scouts should speak with me if interested.

Scoutmaster, Girls (Shawna)

- The girls' holiday party date and location is TBD. They chose to go ice skating, but it has been challenging to settle the plans.
- The girls will do a white elephant gift exchange at the troop meeting on December 18. Everyone is welcome to participate.
- The girls have expressed interest in camping to earn the Horsemanship MB. As an alternative to the spring camporee, a targeted date is possibly April.
- May 3 is Lake Erie Council's Trash the Trash Day service event. The girls will participate.
- May's campout will focus on the Cooking MB or Kayaking MB.

Outdoor/Activities Chair, Boys (Craig)

- Early bird pricing for the January Klondike ends December 29. Early birds are \$35 then the price increases to \$48. Craig is doing the registrations for the Klondike.
- Whirlyball is December 11. An email will go out to the boys' troop with details.
- The boys' troop has discussed returning to Observatory Park for an April or May campout. There is also a discussion about doing something in the spring at The Meadows in Brecksville.

Secretary (Cristie)

- It seems like emails are again arriving in inboxes through our Hostmonster mailing lists. Google Groups have also been established and are working as an alternative email communication method.

Fundraising

- Discussion: Combining fundraising efforts for both troops. What fundraisers are allowed by the parish? What types of fundraisers are approved by Lake Erie Council? What alternative fundraisers (jointly or separately) could we have? Can we do something after Scout Sunday mass? If hosting combined fundraisers, how to divide funds equitably amongst the troops or all parish Scouting units?

 - Girls: Maher Family to discuss taking on coordination of spaghetti dinner.
 - Venture Crew runs a pancake breakfast.
- Discussion tabled for a separate meeting focused on unit fundraising.

Service Projects (no report)

• Pack 652 will be caroling at Oaks of Brecksville on December 18. All are invited to attend to sing standard holiday songs. A song sheet will be provided in advance to print out and bring with you. Arrive at Oaks at 5:50 PM in class A uniform with festive extras. The caroling will take about an hour. Contact Robby Maher for any questions.

IV. Old business

- 652B Campership Program: The boys' troop will institute a scholarship program for troop scouts. Annually, there will be two camperships available for scouts to apply for. One campership will be awarded by the program leaders and one campership will be awarded by the committee. Camperships are intended to award outstanding scouts for their participation in Scouting and to help defray the cost of attending summer camps or high adventure activities. Applications will be created and made available to all troop members. The committee will recruit outside reviewers to read applications and recommend awards. Potential to announce campership awardees at a spring troop Court of Honor before summer camp season. Details will be announced to the troop as they are available.
- 652G Campership Program (The Ella Fund): 652G will adopt an application process for girls' troop members interested in attending high adventure camps.
- A joint planning meeting will be held with all troop leaders (SMs, ASMs) to align both troop calendars.

V. New business

- Units must complete the charter renewal (\$100) by December 13. If using a credit card, there is a 3% fee. No fee for cash or check.
- Jerry offered to take all four of the unit renewals, including forms and fees, to council's office in Downtown Cleveland before the deadline.
- Discussion: Marc inquired about earning the Catholic religious emblem Ad Altare Dei and who to contact. Who at the parish is trained for this award? Denise said Lake Erie Council just had this at the monthly Roundtable and will track down the contact information from Roundtable or through council.
- VI. Announcements
 - Membership renewal emails were issued by Lake Erie Council. Most of our troop members have a January 1-December 31 membership unless you joined recently at a different time of year. If you intend to stay in Scouts BSA, please don't ignore the renewal email. If you do not renew your membership in BSA, you cannot attend troop meetings and activities.
 - Note: Troop dues are separate from BSA membership fees and are collected mid-year in June.
